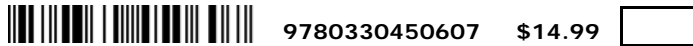

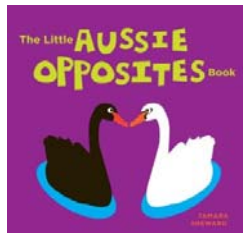

Little Aussie Opposites Book, The

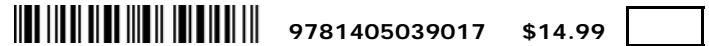

Reckoning, The

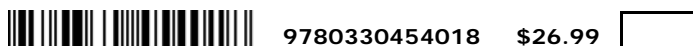
