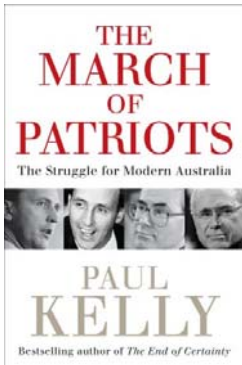

'The March of Patriots' looks at the creation of a new Australian Settlement during the 1991-2003 era of Paul Keating and John Howard.

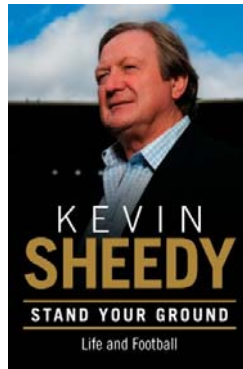
