
## Create your own 'Blooming Heart Bunting'

## What You'll Need

- \* Paper scissors
- \* Glue
- \* Sticky tape
- \* Wrapping paper or coloured paper
- \* Ribbon, twine or string

## What To Do

- 1. Work out the number of pieces you want in your bunting design. Handy hint odd numbers work well.
- 2. Print off your hearts and cut them out, leaving 1 cm of paper around the outside edge. Cover the back of each heart with glue. Press the glued side onto the back of the coloured paper so you can see the dark outline of the template shape and the word 'cut'.
- 3. Wait until your template has dried before cutting it out. Then, lay your bunting shapes in a row, leaving 2 cm between each heart. Unwind your ribbon or twine the same length as the bunting and allow an extra 25 cm at each end.
- 4. Cut the line that says 'cut' on the template. Feed the twine or ribbon through. Use sticky tape to secure your twine or ribbon in place so the template pieces don't slide around.
  - 5. Hang up your bunting!
